BEEFSTEAK Fruits are deep red, smooth-skinned, meaty and juicy with an average weight < 2 lbs. Indeterminate vines have excellent disease resistance resulting in yields nearly double that of other beefsteak varieties.

CHEROKEE PURPLE Indeterminate, 12-16 oz. dark pink-purple fruits have an excellent complex flavor, slightly sweet aftertaste, perfect for slicing.

EARLY GIRL Indeterminate, 4-6 oz. fruit with the old-fashioned tangy tomato taste. Plants are heavy bearing and vigorous with great resistance to verticillium wilt. Color is crimson red.

GERMAN JOHNSON Indeterminate, 8 - > 16 oz. fruit with smooth tops, good for slicing & canning with few seeds. Very productive and fairly resistant to disease.

SUNGOLD Indeterminate. F-1 hybrid Exceptionally sweet, bright tangerine-orange cherry tomatoes. Vigorous plants start yielding early and bear right through the season.

SWEET VALENTINE Determinate, F-1 hybrid. Well-branched determinate patio-type tomato with heart-shaped fruit and a very compact self-mounding or cascading plant habit. This unique plant stays compact (12-16 in.) in height and produces tasty fruits borne in abundance. Color is red
