Plant	Plants that repel	Tackles
Basil <i>Ocimum basilicum</i>	variety of pests	repels cucumber beetles, root flies, other pests
Carrot <i>Daucus carota</i>	deters onion flies	
Catmint <i>Nepeta cataria</i>	deters flea beetles, weevils, ants	
Celery <i>Apium graveolens</i>	deters cabbage butterflies	deters beetles & fleas
Chives <i>Allium schoenoprasum</i>	cures blackspot on roses, stops insects around fruit trees	deters beetles, cabbage moths, carrot fly and lots more – good all-rounder
Dead nettle <i>Lamium album</i>	deters potato pests	deters moths & maggots on a variety of plants
Dill <i>Anethum graveolens</i>	repels aphids & spider mites	repels moths & maggots on various plants
Garlic <i>Allium sativum</i>	repels many insects/pests	does loads, but can be invasive
Hyssop <i>Hyssopus officinalis</i>	repels flea beetles & insects	repels whitefly
Leek <i>Allium ampeloprasum</i>	repels carrot fly	repels whitefly especially on cabbage
Marigold <i>Tagetes –all</i>	reduces nematodes, deals with many pests	one for deterring insects, slugs, snails, mice
Nasturtium <i>Tropaeolum majus</i>	repels aphids, cabbage worms & whitefly	
Onion <i>Allium cepa</i>	deters carrot fly

Vegetable	Good companions	Bad companions
Asparagus	parsley, tomato	onion
Beans	beet, borage, cabbage, carrot corn, marigolds, potato strawberry, tomato	chives, fennel, onions
Beetroot	cabbage	runner bean
Broccoli	beans, celery, chamomile, dill, nasturtium, onion, potato, sage	lettuce, tomato
Brussels sprout	bean, celery, hyssop, nasturtium, potato, rosemary, sage	strawberry
Cabbage	bean, beet, celery, chamomile, dill, onion, rosemary, sage, wormwood	strawberry
Carrot	onions – leek (best), pea, radish rosemary, sage, wormwood	dill
Cauliflower	bean, beet, celery, chamomile, dill, hyssop, nasturtium, onion potato, sage	strawberry, toms
Celery	bean, cabbage, leek, onions, toms	
Courgette	bean, sweet corn, nasturtium, radish	potato
Cucumber	bean, celery, lettuce, pea, radish tomato

Potato	bean, cabbage, dead nettle, lettuce, marigold, onion, pea, radish	apple, pumpkin, sunflower
Pumpkin	bean, sweet corn, nasturtium, radish	potato
Radish	bean, cabbage, cauliflower, courgette, cucumber, lettuce, lettuce, pea, tomato	hyssop
Spinach	cabbage, celery, onion, pea, particularly strawberry
